Through enriched curriculum experiences, accelerated learning opportunities, and a focus on higher-order thinking, Zenith students are challenged to reach their full potential within a stimulating and supportive environment.

Zenith Program - Requirements

Students accepted into the Zenith Program are expected to maintain a high standard of commitment and performance. To retain their place in the program, students must continue to meet the outlined academic and behavioural expectations.

If a student does not meet these requirements, parents and carers will be notified, and appropriate support will be offered. Continued failure to meet program expectations may result in the student being moved out of the Zenith class.

Criteria for acceptance and continuation in the Zenith Program:

- Students must maintain a “B” result or higher in the 4 core subjects: English, Maths, Science, Humanities.
- Students must maintain a grade point average of a “B” or above. This means that their report card results in total must average at a “B” level or higher for all subjects studied in a reporting period.
- Students must maintain a Good Standing at all times. Good Standing is a criterion used by the school that monitors student behaviour, effort and attendance. To maintain Good Standing students must have attendance at or above 95% and ensure that they do not demonstrate unacceptable behaviour at any time whilst at school.
- Homework in all classes must be completed to a satisfactory standard.

What is the Year 7 Zenith Program?

The Zenith program is a course for academically talented Junior Secondary School Students to better meet their needs, ensuring they develop intellectually and to their full potential.

The Zenith program allows bright and highly motivated students to be grouped together so they can be challenged and encouraged by their peers to work hard and continue to succeed in their studies. Students may work at a higher level or faster pace and will also be challenged to develop higher order thinking skills. This program will assist in preparing students for their senior years of schooling and continue to engage them and enhance their love of learning.

Who should apply?

Current year 6 students who are performing well academically and are highly motivated would be suited to this program.

Students in the Zenith program will study both Spanish and Japanese in Year 7. In Year 8, they choose either Japanese or Spanish.

NOTE: Young Scholars need to apply for the Zenith Program.

Where does the program lead to?

In Year 8 and Year 9, students achieving at the highest level, will have the opportunity to participate in our KIN'MA classes for the 4 core subjects (English, Maths, Science, Humanities).

Students will be invited into one or more of these classes based on their academic results at the end of Term 3 Year 7.

Students will need to continue to achieve at this level to keep their position in KIN'MA classes. Within their senior schooling, (Years 11 and 12) students will have the opportunity to select Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority subjects (QCAA).

What do students study within the Zenith program?

- Curriculum subjects may be covered in greater depth.
- Emphasis on reading, writing and higher order thinking skills.
- Involvement in extracurricular activities and community service projects.
- Emphasis on success in examinations.
- Opportunity to be involved in national and international academic competitions.
- Study of foreign languages (Japanese and Spanish in years 7 and 8).
- Involvement in Career Planning Programs.
