

Mountain Creek State High School STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME, SUBJECT FEES AND USER PAYS INFORMATION

Mountain Creek State High School operates a Student Resource Scheme as per Department of Education guidelines. The Student Resource Scheme includes textbooks and/or educational resources that, in the absence of the scheme, would normally be purchased by the parent for the student's use at school and may include printed material such as workbooks and worksheets, produced by the school in lieu of a prescribed textbook to enhance the student's learning experience. The scheme also supplies student and subject resources where the core curriculum is extended through provision of practical learning experiences and materials e.g. art and craft supplies; cooking materials, manual arts materials.

In addition to the Student Resource Scheme this school charges Subject Fees and User Pays (as activities occur).

Subject Fees: Some subjects require students to use materials to fulfil assessment requirements. For example, in Art students produce paintings, in Design and Technology students design and produce a number of workshop items. These projects become the personal property of students. The Subject fee is for the costs of materials used in producing these items.

User Pays: User Pays are for external charges to the school, for example bus hire, admission costs, guest speakers and camp fees. Where a third party charges the school for the activity a User Pay fee is charged to the parent/guardian. Invoices for User Pay activities will be sent out to Parent/Carers in the weeks leading up to the activity. User Pays are to be balanced for each activity and a refund must be given if the amount calculated for the refund is over \$10 per student (as per School Refund Policy, endorsed by the P & C Association).
