

BYOD Minimum SpecificationsLaptop Purchasing Advice

Mountain Creek State High School recommends that all laptops used by students meet the minimum specifications below to enable suitability for curriculum-based activities. The minimum specifications provided reflect the requirements for connection to the school's Wi-Fi network (BYOxLink). School ICT technicians will make every effort to enable connectivity of devices which meet these minimum specifications, assuming there are no technical or other issues outside of their control.

- ✓ Student subject choices and interests should be considered when deciding whether to purchase a device in the Minimum, Medium or High categories below.
- ✓ We recommend all new laptop purchases are 2-in-1 devices which include features of both tablet and laptops. Increasingly such devices will be needed as we move towards paperless delivery of content and assessment. A sample of these devices are listed in the purchasing portal(s) linked at the end of this document and all retail stores will stock their versions.

Important Notes:

- Students will need Administrator access to the device for the initial on-boarding (connecting). They will also need any software that has been installed to limit their access turned off / removed for the connection to be successful. Once the initial on-boarding is complete, restrictions can be reactivated without the student losing network access.
- * Year 7-12 Design/Technology/Engineering subjects listed below, <u>require Windows devices ONLY</u> to run Autodesk software and minimum 16GB RAM.

Mac systems **DO NOT** come with an in-built antivirus however, antivirus programs are available for Macs (ask the supplier for assistance). Wireless 802.11ac Wi-Fi (support of 5GHz wireless range is essential) Connectivity Protection / Device protection plans (both warranty and accidental damage) are strongly recommended with all Accidental laptops and should be discussed at time of purchase. **Damage Plan** When purchasing a device, we encourage families to consider future laptop needs. Generally, as **Important Note:** students move from Junior to Senior grades, their laptop specs will become higher depending on the subjects they intend to study.

- iPads and other tablets are not suitable as they do not meet the minimum specifications above.
- Chromebooks and Microsoft Surface X are not supported on the Mountain Creek SHS network as they are currently incompatible with the network.
- Surface RT, Google ChromeOS, Android and Windows 10 S are not supported Operating Systems and will not connect to the school network. Windows 10 S can be upgraded at home for free, please visit this link and register using the students school account Windows 10 Education
- Norton Family, AVG, Avast and TotalAV products are NOT compatible and interfere with internet connectivity on the school network. Please don't install or subscribe to these services.
