ATAR & QCE

20 points

The Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) and the ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admission Rank) are different and have a different purpose.

Score out of 100



QCE

Certifies learning, showing the individual has achieved a specific standard of education at senior schooling level and may be considered by employers and the general community.



ATAR

Tells us about a student's position (or ranking) compared to all other students in the state. The only intended purpose for the ATAR is to assist with selecting applicants for tertiary study.






What is the QCE?

•The QCE is Queensland's senior schooling qualification.

- Internationally recognised
- Shows student achievement
- Flexible
- Wide range of learning options





How does the QCE work?

- Set amount: 20 credits
- Set pattern:
 - 12 credits from completed
 Core courses
 - 8 credits from Core,Preparatory &Complementary courses
- Satisfactory completion
- Literacy & numeracy





ATAR eligibility

- To be eligible for an ATAR, students must successfully complete:
 - 5 General subjects, or
 - 4 General subjects + 1 Applied subject or completed VET qualification at Certificate III or above.
- Students must also successfully complete an English subject.





Tertiary entrance

- The ATAR is used nationally to measure a student's position relative to other ATAReligible students.
- The Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC) will calculate and issue ATARs.

Nationally recognised





Can contribute toward the calculation of an ATAR (Certificate III or higher)



Provide industry relevant knowledge and skills that are valued by employers



Support students in their transition to employment, vocational and higher education pathways



Can be studied as part of your school subjects even if you want to go to university



Can assist students to gain a part-time job while at university
